

## What is it?

Speech and Debate covers a lot of different activities. The Speech side is primarily for those with either literary or a dramatic interest. Students present scenes from plays, novels and stories in performance, or perhaps deliver speeches they themselves have written on a particular aspect of modern society that they find worth analysis. They can be funny, sad, or thought-provoking—or all three. On the Debate side we mostly engage in Lincoln-Douglas Debate, a one-on-one activity where the topics usually revolve around issues of right and wrong. We answer questions like, Is Capital Punishment moral? Or, Is Civil Disobedience justified? The topics change every two months, and all debaters must, at every tournament, debate both sides of the resolution. The arguing is fast, furious, and fun.
