In an effort to get all debate judges on the same page, we suggest the following guidelines.


Use 10ths of points


The Live Doc had everything everyone needed to know—debaters, coaches, judges. It was the complete guide to the tournament in advance and as it was happening.

We spent hours putting them together and keeping them upto-date.




